



# PLAYER / PARENT AGREEMENT

NGCNA has established a set of policies to ensure that coaches, players, parents and spectators adhere to certain guidelines and expectations. These policies are designed to promote a positive and respectful environment whilst ensuring the well-being of all those involved. One of these policies is the NGCNA Player/Parent/Guardian Agreement and this agreement references other NGCNA Policies and Netball Qld Code of Conduct & Integrity Policy. These documents can be found on our website. Please familiarise yourself with these policies prior to accepting a position on an NGCNA Representative team or squad.

## What is the Player / Parent / Guardian Agreement?

Upon selection into an NGCNA Representative Team, a Google Forms document will be emailed to the parent/guardian asking to provide the player's personal details and medical information. You will also be asked to either agree or disagree with the statements pertaining to medical consent, fees, court time and all NGCNA policies. The rules within the NGCNA policies and procedures apply regardless of whether you have made yourself aware of these or not.

It is important that all players are committed, reliable and focused during training and competition. Players are expected to attend all set training sessions, carnivals and competitions. We ask parents to be supportive and assist each player to fulfil their responsibilities during the representative netball season. Players, parents and guardians are expected to abide by all NGCNA Policies and Netball Qld Code of Conduct & Integrity.

The Player/Parent/Guardian Agreement must be signed before commencement of season training, agreeing to abide by the conditions and procedures outlined in the document. A breach of these agreements may result in the dismissal of the player from the Rep Program and a possible ban for future years.
